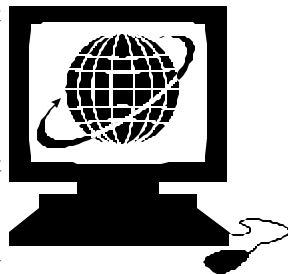

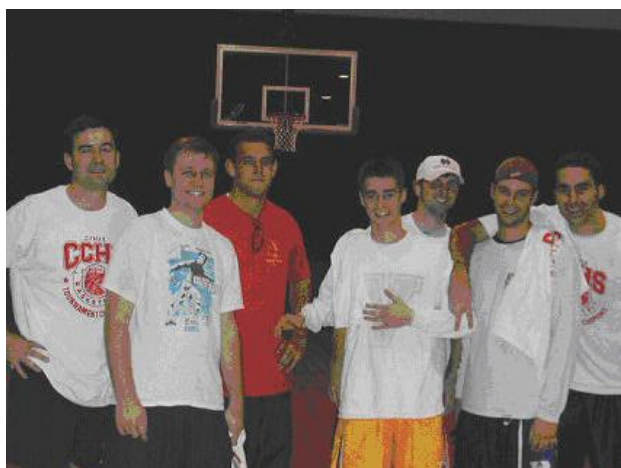
Alumni Basketball Tournament

Sports Hall of Fame (SHOF) Nominations

To make a nomination for the CCHS Sports Hall of Fame, please include the following information, in writing:

1. Name and class of individual or team being nominated.
2. Nominee's extraordinary accomplishments at CCHS.
3. League/City/Regional/National Honors while at CCHS.
4. Additional athletic background (including post-CCHS years).
5. Name, address, and phone number of the individual making the nomination.
6. A brief, personal testimonial as to why you feel the nominee should be elected to the SHOF.

The rules for the nomination and selection process are outlined as follows:

1. Nominations to the SHOF can be made by anyone by writing with the above required nominee information to "Sports Hall of Fame Nominations," 7702 Pineville-Matthews Rd., Charlotte, NC 28226.
2. In-depth background research and the typed or written presentation of the nominee's accomplishments are the sole responsibility of the alumni making the nomination; clarity and completeness will, of course, be extremely helpful in the decision-making process.
3. When a nominee is not selected, the nomination will be carried over for consideration for the next five years. If the nomination is not selected for induction by the time the five years pass, the nomination will have to be re-submitted.
4. In order to be considered for the Hall of Fame, a candidate must have demonstrated superior capability in any sport sponsored by CCHS. Prime emphasis will be placed on the candidate's athletic achievements at CCHS, although additional information on post-CCHS athletic accomplishments will be considered to a lesser degree.
5. Membership of the SHOF will include primarily living or deceased Alumni.
6. The race, creed, color or gender of the candidate will have no bearing on selection.
7. A period of ten years must elapse after graduation before any alumni is eligible for consideration; ten years must also elapse before any team or non-graduate is eligible.
8. Individuals or teams will be admitted.
9. No more than eight inductees will be admitted annually.

Distinguished Alumni Award Nominations

The CCHS Distinguished Alumni Award will be given to an Alumni of CCHS, Our Lady of Mercy or O'Donoghue who has demonstrated excellence in his or her life. This person represents the mission of excellence of CCHS in everything he or she has done. To make a nomination, please send a detailed list of the alumni's accomplishments. The list should include such information as education, awards and accomplishments, family life, community service, work excellence, and leadership positions. The person making the nomination does not need to be an alumni. He or she should also include a brief testimonial on why this alumni should be recognized.
