

Friends and family have created a scholarship for Charlotte Catholic students headed to the University of Notre Dame in the name of **Dan Sullivan** '83 who died in 2008 at age 43 after an 11-year fight with brain cancer.

While at Catholic, Dan was a four-year Cougar Award winner and earned the William C. Ward Prize for Excellence in Algebra. He played varsity soccer and served as a class officer. Dan graduated as co-valedictorian in 1983. In his commencement address, he reminded classmates they can do anything they can imagine.

Dan graduated from Notre Dame in 1987 and received a master's degree in business from Northwestern University. He enjoyed a career in marketing and a wonderful family with three children in Cincinnati, Ohio with Andrea, his wife of 16 years. His battle with cancer was inspirational to many around him. He never asked "why me?" and he never lost his deeply-felt religious faith.
